MOTION NO. 8400

A MOTION approving the 1992 1% for Art Project Plan.

WHEREAS, the King County arts commission is required by Ordinance 9134 to present for approval by the council an annual 1% for Arts Projects Plan which identifies and describes art projects to be initiated during the next budget year from the 1% for Art Fund, and

WHEREAS, the King County arts commission has prepared a document entitled 1992 Percent for Art Annual Plan identifying and describing arts projects in response to Ordinance 9134, and

WHEREAS, the Council of King County finds that the 1992 Percent for Art Annual Plan is in conformity with the council's intent for use of 1% for Arts Program funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The 1992 Percent for Art Annual Plan is hereby approved for the 1992 budget year.

B. 1992 Percent Projects financed with pooled funds contributed by solid waste bonds subfund 3202 including the Enumclaw, Factoria and Hobart Transfer Stations shall be used to mitigate the impact of the project in the local community in which they are sited.

C. The cultural resources division shall work with solid waste division citizen advisory committees and local community interests in determining the best use for Percent for Art funds in mitigating the impact on the community accepting the transfer station.
