

MOTION NO. **8427**

A MOTION requesting the executive to negotiate an interlocal agreement with Snohomish County related to solid waste management and planning.

WHEREAS, Snohomish County officials have expressed an interest in entering into an interlocal agreement covering certain solid waste management activities, and

WHEREAS, the public interest of both Snohomish County and King County would be served by the two county governments negotiating an agreement on solid waste management and planning policies and practices that address their mutual and respective concerns;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The executive is hereby requested to negotiate and forward to the council for approval an interlocal agreement with Snohomish County addressing:

- 1) the designation of disposal sites pursuant to RCW 36.58.040 for franchised haulers operating under a franchise that covers both King and Snohomish Counties;
- 2) the inter-county handling of construction, demolition, and land clearing waste; and
- 3) coordination of the King and Snohomish County solid waste management plans as they relate to solid wastes generated and/or collected in North King and South Snohomish Counties.
