MOTION NO. 8440

A MOTION authorizing the executive to proceed with demolition of structures at the Lake Burien School Site Park.

WHEREAS, a recent parks division study determined that Burien is the unincorporated area in King County most in need of additional park development and,

WHEREAS, the council has appropriated \$433,000 for the acquisition of the Lake Burien Baptist School Site in order to develop a 5-acre park and,

WHEREAS, the council has appropriated \$630,000 to fund demolition or rehabilitation of the deteriorated buildings at this park site and,

WHEREAS, the council required the executive to conduct an analysis to determine if these buildings should be rehabilitated or demolished and,

WHEREAS, the council prohibited the expenditure of funds on construction or demolition until the council reviewed the executive analysis and approved one of these alternatives and,

WHEREAS, in August, 1991, the parks division completed an analysis which determined that the cost of rehabilitating the structures at this park site was excessive and that these structures should be demolished and,
