A MOTION recognizing the continuance of an emergency condition of the Redondo Seawall along Beach Road South, requiring immediate repair of a county road and seawall, waiving requirements for competitive bidding for such repairs and ratifying and confirming the Local Proclamation of Emergency issued by the King County executive on September 16, 1991.

WHEREAS, the King County office of emergency management has reported to the King County executive that an imminent and unpredictable danger exists due to the condition of the Redondo Seawall along Beach Road South, and

WHEREAS, the work performed by King County in December, 1990 to shore up a disintegrating seawall represents only a temporary solution for the seawall which is not expected to withstand a major storm, and

WHEREAS, a major storm of the magnitude which would destroy the temporary maintenance work may occur at any time, and

WHEREAS, further destruction of the seawall would pose a threat to persons and property and could cause major environmental degradation due to the potential that a major sanitary sewer line would immediately discharge raw sewage into Puget Sound if damaged, and

WHEREAS, the severity and magnitude of this emergency is beyond the response and recovery capability of local resources, and

WHEREAS, the ordinary requirements for formal competitive bidding of the construction contracts pursuant to R.C.W. 36.32 and the purchase of tangible personal property pursuant to K.C.C. 4.16 for such repairs must be waived in order to prevent delay in beginning such repair work, and

WHEREAS, there is a continuing emergency present which necessitates activation of the King County disaster
