## MOTION NO. 8450

A MOTION authorizing the King County executive to make a grant application in 1991 to the Urban Mass Transportation Administration through Metro for funds in the approximate amount of \$75,200 to support funding for an Automobile Vehicle Occupancy Study on local arterials for the northern Seattle-King County Region.

WHEREAS, the federal Urban Mass Transportation Administration

(UMTA) makes Section 9. Intercounty Projects Program grant funds

available to the urbanized areas of Snohomish County and King County,

and

WHEREAS, the Intercounty Projects Committee has reviewed project proposals for inclusion in the grant application and recommended the Automobile Vehicle Occupancy Study be included for funding, and

WHEREAS, Metro, notified King County of the Section 9. Intercounty Projects Program, is authorized to apply for UMTA funds on behalf of King County and disburse those funds to King County, and

WHEREAS, King County desires to conduct an Automobile Vehicle
Occupancy Study on local arterials to support work efforts on the
Arterial High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) Program and Transportation Demand
Management (TDM) actions, and

WHEREAS, the grant application process will be initiated in late 1991 through Metro and funds will be available by early 1992, and

WHEREAS, King County recognizes an obligation to provide the amount of \$18,800 for in-kind services for the duration of the grant period, and

WHEREAS, the department of public works' budget provides funds for Metro coordination;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the approximate amount of \$75,200 to the Urban Mass Transportation Administration through Metro to implement an Automobile Vehicle Occupancy Study on local arterials.
- B. The King County executive is hereby authorized to enter into an interlocal agreement with Metro to allow for disbursement of funds.

C. The King County executive is hereby authorized to file and
execute such contracts and documents as are required by the grantor.
