A MOTION honoring the 100 anniversary of the founding of the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers and establishing the week of November 24th to the 30th as International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers Week in King County.

WHEREAS, the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers (IBEW) was founded on November 29, 1891; and

WHEREAS, the IBEW has served to working men and women in the electrical industry for 100 years; and

WHEREAS, IBEW Local 77 was first chartered in Seattle in 1897; and

WHEREAS, IBEW Local 46 was first chartered in Seattle in 1914; and

WHEREAS, the IBEW established an apprenticeship program within its first year of being chartered; and

WHEREAS, the IBEW and Locals 46 and 77 continue to serve the working men and women and the community at-large in Seattle, King County and the State of Washington;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: that the week of November 24th through November 30th of 1991 be established as International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers week in King County to honor the 100 years of service by the IBEW.
