MOTION NO. 8460

A MOTION proclaiming December 1991 as the
Bill of Rights Bicentennial in King County.

WHEREAS, 1991 marks the two hundredth anniversary of the
ratification of the Bill of Rights, a cornerstone of American
freedom, and

WHEREAS, the Bill of Rights has preserved the rights of all
individuals in this country for the last two hundred years, and

WHEREAS, the inalienable rights of life, liberty and the
pursuit of happiness are fundamental to all human beings, not
just the citizens of this nation, and

WHEREAS, recent events around the world have inspired
oppressed peoples to intensify their quests for human rights,
and

WHEREAS, it is therefore fitting that we, as American
citizens, should commemorate these rights and strive to
preserve and protect their promise;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

December 1991 is hereby proclaimed as the Bill of Rights
Bicentennial in King County, and all citizens are asked to join
in the commemoration of those rights.

BE IT FURTHER MOVED:

The Council asks all public schools in King County to
devote significant attention during the month of December to
teaching the values in the Bill of Rights.
