MOTION NO. 8481

A MOTION authorizing the King County executive to submit an application to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for \$2.117 million in 1992 HOME Investment Partnership Act funds.

WHEREAS, Title II of the National Affordable Housing Act provides for the HOME Investment Partnership Act which is a formula-based housing production program to be administered by State and local governments, and

WHEREAS, the county, as the lead agency in the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Consortium with 26 cities and towns, will administer HOME Investment Partnership funds throughout the CDBG Consortium, and

WHEREAS, the King County Consortium is entitled to approximately \$2.117 million in 1992 HOME funds based upon a national budget appropriation of \$1.5 billion, and

WHEREAS, the federal government through the regulations of the National Affordable Housing Act, requires King County to submit an application for the HOME funds to HUD, and these funds will be appropriated by the King County council in 1992;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County executive is hereby authorized to submit an application for 1992 HOME Investment Partnership funds to HUD.
