A MOTION supporting the Open Space Citizen Oversight Committee's recommendation for allocation of conservation futures levy proceeds to King County and the City of Seattle, for the purpose of providing funding for open space acquisition activities.

WHEREAS, R.C.W. 84.34.230 grants the right to levy a property tax for the purpose of acquiring conservation futures in real property, pursuant to R.C.W. 84.34.210 and R.C.W. 84.43.220, and

WHEREAS, by ordinance, conservation futures levy proceeds are collected by King County, and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 8667, as amended by Ordinance No. 9430 (codified as K.C.C. 26.12) establishes King County's policies and procedures regarding distribution of conservation futures levy proceeds to King County and the City of Seattle, and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 9128 appropriates funds for King County and the City of Seattle to use for open space acquisition and related expenses, and

WHEREAS, the King County Code directs the open space oversight committee to review and make recommendations to the executive towards all requests for conservation futures levy proceeds, and

WHEREAS, the open space citizen oversight committee has reviewed the requests from King County and the City of Seattle;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The King County council hereby approves the allocation of conservation futures levy proceeds to the projects and in the amount listed in Attachment A.

1 B. The executive is authorized to enter into and execute  
2 contracts and interlocal agreements that may be necessary for  
3 the distribution of these funds.

**Clark Lake (Mordhorst parcel)** is a 73 acre parcel located at the west end of Clark Lake on Southeast 248th Street.

**Brunton Farm Replacement** (Cedar River Associates parcel) is a 45 acre parcel located along the Cedar River near Route 169 in the Maple Valley area.

**Cougar Mountain Completion** is a 201 acre parcel at the east end of Cougar Mountain near the Renton-Issaquah Road.

## City of Seattle

**Mountain View Natural Area** is located at Mountain View Drive South and South Columbian Way in Seattle.

**Pelly Place Natural Area** is located along Murray Avenue Southwest in Seattle.

**Duwamish Head Greenbelt (College Street Ravine)** is located at Sunset Avenue Southwest in Seattle.

**NE Queen Anne Greenbelt** is located along Aurora Boulevard (State Route 99) in the Queen Anne neighborhood in Seattle.
