2 A MOTION certifying that the construction
3 of the Southeast Lake Sammamish
4 Interceptor Section 1 is consistent with
5 King County Plans and Policies.

6 WHEREAS, METRO Resolution 2933 and King County Ordinance
7 4226 require King County council certification of proposed
8 connections to METRO facilities when they would provide the
9 potential for sewer service to unincorporated areas of King
10 County, and

11 WHEREAS, on June 20, 1991, METRO requested certification
12 of the construction of the Southeast Lake Sammamish Interceptor
13 Section 1 (Attachment A dated January 22, 1992), and

14 WHEREAS, the proposed connection has been reviewed by the
15 department of parks, planning and resources which has
16 recommended approval of the proposed connection subject to
17 conditions, and

18 WHEREAS, King County Ordinance 4226 specifies that the
19 King County council will grant or deny such proposals by
20 motion;

21 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

22 1. Subject to the following conditions and limitations,
23 the METRO Southeast Lake Sammamish Interceptor Section 1 is
24 found to be consistent with King County plans and policies as
25 required by METRO Resolution 2933 and King County Ordinance
26 4226:

27 a. This certification of Section 1 does not authorize
28 sewer service to either Rural designated areas of the King
29 County Comprehensive Plan or areas outside Local Service Areas,
30 nor does it indicate council support for a change in such
31 designations;

32 b. Southeast Lake Sammamish Interceptor Section 2 is a
33 separate decision which will require certification at such time
34 construction is proposed; and



c. This certification of Section 1 does not waive any necessary environmental mitigation for construction of Section 1.


2. The council chair is authorized to sign the form provided by METRO confirming consistency of the interceptor proposal with county plans and policies.
