A MOTION authorizing the county executive to accept a gift of one used passenger van with an approximate total value of \$20,000 from the State of Washington Department of Social and Health Services

WHEREAS, the State of Washington Department of Social and Health Services Division of Vocational Rehabilitation has selected King County to receive a gift of one Dodge passenger van, and

WHEREAS, the State of Washington Department of Social and Health Services Division of Vocational Rehabilitation has delivered said vehicle to the King County garage, and

WHEREAS, the State of Washington Department of Social and Health Services Division of Vocational Rehabilitation has recommended the King County parks division use the van, and

WHEREAS, the King County parks division has immediate need for the van to transport workers with disabilities to job sites, and

WHEREAS, King County will be given title to the van and will have full authority regarding its future use and eventual disposal, and

WHEREAS, citizens of King County with developmental disabilities will benefit from acceptance of the gift, and

WHEREAS, the proposed use of the gift is consistent with the King County Developmental Disabilities 1989-91 Biennial Plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to accept the gift of one van from the Department of Social and Health Services Division of Vocational Rehabilitation.


1 B. The King County executive is hereby authorized to  
2 execute documents as are required by State law and by the  
3 grantor to transfer title and ownership of the vehicle to King  
4 County.

5 C. The King County executive is hereby authorized to enter  
6 into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for use of  
7 the van.

8 D. The King County executive is also authorized to sell or  
9 otherwise convey this property in accordance with King County  
10 Code Chapter 4.56.
