A MOTION requesting the Executive to
prepare an interim plan and cost estimate
for using Redondo Beach Drive.

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the King County
council that commuters from Federal Way and Southwest King
County communities are being negatively impacted by the
continued closure of the storm damaged Redondo Sea Wall and
Redondo Beach Drive, and

WHEREAS, former users and commuters have suggested that
the storm damaged wall and road could be temporarily repaired
to allow interim commuter use while the EIS process is underway
and the permanent, long range solution is fully developed, and

WHEREAS, the King County council, having considered the
citizen commuter's request, have agreed the idea deserves
investigation;


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The executive is requested to investigate the feasibility
of constructing interim repairs to the wall and road which are
sufficient to open the road to commuter and local traffic, and
include off-site traffic impacts and alternate strategies,
safety considerations and cost estimates which would accomplish
the interim road operations.

The executive is requested to conduct studies that are
necessary to accomplish the above and report back alternative
proposals and cost estimates on or before the 20th of March,
1992.
