2 A MOTION authorizing the County Executive
3 to make a grant application for funds in
4 the approximate amount of \$2,900,160 to
5 support a study of case management
6 services, Grant File No. 203.

7 WHEREAS, injecting drug users have been shown to
8 underutilize and utilize inappropriately existing social
9 support and service programs, and

10 WHEREAS, injection drug use is a significant factor in the
11 transmission of the Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV) and the
12 incidence of the Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome (AIDS),
13 and

14 WHEREAS, a significant number of inmates released from the
15 King County jail admit to the use of illicit drugs by
16 injection, and

17 WHEREAS, case management services have been shown to
18 improve treatment outcomes and reduce the inappropriate use of
19 social and health services in certain groups, and

20 WHEREAS, the impact of office-based and community-based
21 case management services on an injecting drug using population
22 has not been documented in research, and

23 WHEREAS, the case management services study will enable the
24 collection of data regarding the results of different forms of
25 case management services to individuals released from the King
26 County jail and enable evaluation of the results of the
27 different services, and

28 WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services,
29 through the National Institute on Drug Abuse, is empowered to
30 make grants in support of programs which could improve the
31 effectiveness of drug abuse treatment services and help to
32 reduce the spread of HIV/AIDS in this country;

33 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

34 A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to make
35 application for funds in the approximate amount of \$2,900,160

1 to the Department of Health and Human Services, National
2 Institute on Drug Abuse, for a study of case management
3 services available to injecting drug users on behalf of King
4 County;

5 B. The King County executive is hereby authorized to file
6 and execute such application and to enter into and execute such
7 contracts as are required by the grantor;

8 C. The Department of Health and Human Services, National
9 Institute on Drug Abuse is hereby assured to full compliance
10 with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act.
