WHEREAS, the merit selection process requires approximately three months to fill judicial vacancies in District Court, and

WHEREAS, the council could not fill the Federal Way judicial vacancy until June 1992 due to the time it takes to complete the merit selection process, and

WHEREAS, this judicial position will be filled by the voters in the general election in November 1992, and

WHEREAS, the filing deadline for seeking election to this judicial position is July 1992;
