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A MOTION accepting the Interim Redondo Beach Road South report and recommending the one-way northbound full length option as a safe, interim plan for reopening the road to traffic.

MOTION NO.

WHEREAS, the executive has conducted studies to investigate the feasibility of constructing interim repairs to the Redondo Beach Drive South collector arterial road and seawall, and

WHEREAS, the report, dated March 30, 1992, submitted to the council, analyzed the feasibility of constructing interim road repairs to permit opening of the road to traffic while the final environmental review process is being completed, and

WHEREAS, the interim report includes a description of the design features, traffic flows, environmental issues, emergency response routes, estimates of construction costs and the approximate time for construction of the interim improvements for six feasible on-site alternatives, and a number of off-site improvements, sufficient to open the road to commuter and local traffic, and

WHEREAS the interim report finds six alternatives are feasible for the interim operation of the Redondo Beach Drive South road and will provide relief from delays and traffic congestion on alternative detour routes;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County Council has considered the Final Study for the Interim Improvements to Beach Road South, dated March 30, 1992, which considers six interim alternatives which would permit the safe, interim operation of Redondo Beach Drive South.
