MOTION NO. 8607

A MOTION declaring the intention of the King County Council to dissolve Road Improvement District 106, Uplake Community road improvements and setting a date for a public hearing.

WHEREAS, King County Ordinance No. 8091 created King County Road Improvement District No. 106 for the purpose of providing for the construction of curb and gutter, sidewalks and associated road improvements to a number of streets within the Uplake community, and

WHEREAS, the estimate of cost to complete the project continues to escalate, and

WHEREAS, the estimated costs of the improvements are now at the estimated level of benefit to be received by the properties within the assessment boundary of the road improvement district, and

WHEREAS, the department of public works conducted a property owner survey in November, 1990 to determine support for continuing the project, and

WHEREAS, the results from said survey indicated that barely 51 percent of the property owners favored continuing the project with the caveat that should estimated costs increase then support would be withdrawn, and

WHEREAS, representatives from the department of public works met with community leaders in September, 1991 and presented revised cost estimates reflecting increases over estimates at the time of the property owner survey, and

WHEREAS, the community leaders expressed concern that support of fellow property owners for continuing the project did not now exist, and

WHEREAS, said community leaders support the dissolution of Road Improvement District No. 106;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. It is the intention of the council to dissolve a road improvement district in King County known and designated as "King County Road Improvement District No. 106 (hereinafter "RID 106"), and terminate the proceedings thereof.

B. It is the intention of the county council that any costs incurred to date for preliminary engineering and administration will be applied to any road improvement district created in the future to provide road improvements to streets within the limits of RID 106 to the extent such costs are for work which benefits such later improvements.



At such time and place, the council intends to hear such objections and testimony and to act on the intentions set forth herein.

D. The clerk of the King County council is hereby authorized and directed to give notice of said public hearing by publication and by mailing at the times and in the manner described in RCW 36.88.050 for publication of the resolution of intention to establish a road improvement district.
