A MOTION authorizing the King County Executive to accept a contribution of recycled glass cullet to be used to test pilot applications of recycled glass in road construction.

WHEREAS, King County has adopted a goal of recycling and reducing the waste stream by sixty-five percent by the year 2000, and

WHEREAS, a glut of recycled glass currently exists in King County, and WHEREAS, research is needed regarding the use of recycled glass cullet in road construction applications in order to assess the feasibility of widespread use of recycled glass in King County construction projects, and

WHEREAS, Waste Management, Inc., a refuse hauler located in King County has offered to donate up to 6,000 tons of recycled glass cullet to King County to be used in pilot road construction applications;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The county executive is hereby authorized to accept an in-kind contribution of up to 6,000 tons of recycled glass cullet from Waste Management, Inc., with an estimated market value of \$10.00 per ton, for use in pilot road construction projects.
