A MOTION authorizing the Executive to initiate the requests for qualifications (RFQ) for four Bear Creek Community master plan development transportation studies, prior to Council action on related master plan development legislation

WHEREAS, on January 30, 1989 the King County Council adopted the Bear Creek Community Plan and Area Zoning, and

WHEREAS, two proposed Bear Creek Master Plan Developments (MPD's) containing 2550 acres of urban development are scheduled for a Pre-Development Application hearing in February, 1993, and for Council review and action shortly thereafter, and

WHEREAS, the 1992 Budget Ordinance contained a proviso which requested that the executive submit an agreement for the four Phase I transportation studies and a request for a supplemental budget appropriation to fund these studies, and

WHEREAS, proposed Motion 92-261 and proposed Ordinance 92-260 relating to the road studies agreement and the supplemental appropriation of \$1.4 million to fund the studies are currently pending council study, review and action, and

WHEREAS, the council's intent is to act upon this legislation within the next 30 to 45 days, and

WHEREAS, the process for the request for qualifications (RFQ) for the road study consultants could be expedited, if the council would approve the starting of an RFQ process before the council takes action on the proposed agreement and supplemental appropriation legislation, and

WHEREAS, the county can still maintain the integrity of the consultant selection process, by not signing the contract until after the council has taken action on the pending legislation;
