A MOTION authorizing the executive to enter into an interagency agreement with the City of Seattle and other governmental agencies for the purpose of expanding the northend microwave system.

WHEREAS, the Council by Ordinance 10310 appropriated funds for participation by King County in expansion of the northend microwave system for emergency radio purposes, and

WHEREAS, the Council has authorized execution of an agreement with the City of Seattle providing for the transfer of such funds for such purposes, and

WHEREAS, further discussions with other governmental agencies in King County subsequent to that authorization have established a basis for a regional approach to emergency radio system facilities which, without changing King County's obligations or rights as contemplated in the original authorization, best can be accomplished by a multiparty agreement rather than one only with the City of Seattle,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The executive is authorized to enter into an interagency agreement with the City of Seattle and other appropriate governmental entities, if any, for transfer of \$217,000 in county funds to Seattle for the purposes of expanding the northend microwave system in order to provide sufficient capacity to accommodate the radio traffic which will be generated when the county implements its portion of a regional emergency radio system. It is understood that the cost of this system will be redistributed among participating agencies when the county implements its portion of the emergency radio system.
