A MOTION authorizing an interlocal agreement between King County and the City of Renton to cooperate in the development of a plan to improve water quality in King County.

WHEREAS, the City of Renton and King County share jurisdiction and have a mutual interest in improving water quality in the Cedar River watershed, and

WHEREAS, King County has received a Washington State Department of Ecology Centennial Clean Water Fund Grant to prepare a Nonpoint Pollution Action Plan in the Cedar River Basin, and

WHEREAS, the City of Renton is conducting an extensive sole source aquifer protection program in the incorporated area of the sole source aquifer, and

WHEREAS, by participating in the development of the Action Plan,
Renton can gain important information about the preservation of its domestic water supply and protection of the aquifer in the unincorporated areas of the watershed, and

WHEREAS, the Action Plan is being developed concurrently with a comprehensive basin plan for the Cedar River watershed and the implementation of the two plans will address all facets of the drainage and surface water quality problems in the area;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County executive is hereby authorized to enter into an interlocal agreement in substantially the form attached with the City of Renton for the development of a plan to improve water quality in the Cedar River watershed located in the City and unincorporated King County.
