MOTION NO. **8699**

A MOTION authorizing the executive to submit a grant application for funds in the approximate amount of \$280,220 to support continued development of a regional emergency medical services and trauma system plan, community based continuing medical education services, and injury prevention programs on behalf of the Seattle King County Emergency Medical Services and Trauma Care Council.

WHEREAS, the Washington State Department of Health, Office of Emergency Medical Services and Trauma Systems is authorized to make grants to support development and coordination of regional emergency medical services and trauma systems plans, continuing medical education services for prehospital and hospital providers, and

WHEREAS, the Washington State Department of Health has designated King County as an emergency medical services and trauma region, and

WHEREAS, the Seattle King County Emergency Medical Services and Trauma Care Council has been established pursuant to RCW 18.73, and

WHEREAS, the Seattle King County Emergency Medical Services and Trauma Care Council has designated the King County emergency medical services division as their program and fiscal agent, and

WHEREAS, the King County council finds that the activities supported in the grant are consistent with the responsibilities of the emergency medical services division as set forth in Chapter 2.26 of the King County Code.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the approximate amount of \$280,220 to the Washington State Department of Health, Office of Emergency

6 B. The King County executive is hereby authorized to file
7 and execute such application and enter into and execute such
8 contracts as are required by the grantor.

9 C. The King County executive is also authorized to enter
10 into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the
11 implementation of the projects.

12 D. The department of health is hereby assured full
13 compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act.
