2 A MOTION authorizing the county executive  
3 to make a grant preapplication and  
4 application for funds in the approximate  
5 amount of \$536,400 to support acquisition  
6 of a Crash, Fire and Rescue Vehicle and  
7 the installation of lighted guidance  
8 signs at the King County International  
9 Airport/Boeing Field.

10 WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Transportation, Federal  
11 Aviation Administration, is empowered to make grants to support  
12 improvements at public airports, and

13 WHEREAS, acquisition of a new Crash, Fire and Rescue  
14 Vehicle will enable replacement of a vehicle purchased in 1976  
15 and would improve the emergency response capability of the  
16 airport, and

17 WHEREAS, installation of lighted taxiway guidance signs on  
18 various taxiways will enable the airport to comply with FAA  
19 standards for airport signage systems, and

20 WHEREAS, the Crash, Fire and Rescue Vehicle and the lighted  
21 guidance signs will assist the county in meeting the needs of  
22 users of the King County International Airport/Boeing Field;

23 NOW THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:


24 A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to make a  
25 preapplication and application for funds in the approximate  
26 amount of \$536,400 to the Department of Transportation, Federal  
27 Aviation Administration, to support acquisition of the Crash,  
28 Fire and Rescue Vehicle and the installation of lighted  
29 guidance signs at the King County International Airport/Boeing  
30 Field, on behalf of King County;

31 B. The King County executive is hereby authorized to file  
32 and execute such application and enter into and execute such  
33 contracts as are required by the grantor:

1 C. The Department of Transportation is hereby assured full  
2 compliance with the Title VI of the Civil Rights Act.
