WHEREAS, installation of lighted taxiway guidance signs on various taxiways will enable the airport to comply with FAA standards for airport signage systems, and

WHEREAS, the Crash, Fire and Rescue Vehicle and the lighted guidance signs will assist the county in meeting the needs of users of the King County International Airport/Boeing Field;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County executive is hereby authorized to make a preapplication and application for funds in the approximate amount of \$536,400 to the Deaprtment of Transportation, Federal Aviation Administration, to support acquisition of the Crash, Fire and Rescue Vehicle and the installation of lighted guidance signs at the King County International Airport/Boeing Field, on behalf of King County;
- B. The King County executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such application and enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the grantor:
