A MOTION authorizing the executive to grant a utility easement for a water main to the City of Bellevue in Council District Number 3.

WHEREAS, under King County Code 4.56.010 the King County council may authorize the King County executive to grant an easement through county property, and

WHEREAS, the City of Bellevue is proposing to install, operate and maintain a water main across Tract B, Vuemont Vista Division No. 2, in Council District Number 3, which will loop existing dead-end lines back into the overall distribution system, and

WHEREAS, the City of Bellevue water line improvements will eliminate water stagnation problems, increase fireflow capability, and improve system reliability, and

WHEREAS, the department of public works, surface water management division finds that the granting of this utility easement will not interfere with the use of this property and that the rights requested by the City of Bellevue are surplus to the county's foreseeable needs, and

WHEREAS, One Thousand Nine Hundred Seventy-nine Dollars (\$1,979) in financial consideration shall be made payable to King County office of finance, and shall be assigned to the surface water management division's operating fund, and

WHEREAS, the City of Bellevue has agreed also to perform landscape restoration improvements on both Tract B, owned by King County, and the adjacent Tract A, owned by the Vuemont Vista Homeowners Association, and

WHEREAS, the King County council finds that the easement would be in the best interests of the citizens of King County;

The county executive is authorized to execute a utility easement

for a water main and all necessary appurtenances, substantially in the form of the attached Exhibit "A", for the following described property:

The Easterly 10.00 feet of the Westerly 15.00 feet of Tract B, Vuemont Vista Division No. 2, according to the Plat recorded in Volume 124 of Plats, Pages 99 and 100, records of King County, Washington.
