A MOTION authorizing the executive to grant a pedestrian and bicycle trail easement to the City of Kent in Council District 9.

WHEREAS, under King County Code 4.56.010 the King County council may authorize the King County executive to grant an easement over county property, and

WHEREAS, the City of Kent wishes to construct, operate, and maintain a pedestrian and bicycle trail over a portion of the Aukeen Court/Kent Jail property, in Council District 9, for a portion of the Green River Corridor Trail system, and

WHEREAS, the trail will be constructed over a portion of the Aukeen District Court/Kent Jail property which is owned jointly by King County and the City of Kent, and

WHEREAS, at the time that the property was purchased, a recreational use was anticipated for the jointly-owned portion of the property, and

WHEREAS, the King County district court, Aukeen division, which is the custodial agency, and the King County parks division support the granting of this trail easement, and

WHEREAS, the granting of the easement is considered to be of mutual benefit to King County and the City of Kent, and

WHEREAS, the King County council finds that the granting of this trail easement will not interfere with the use of the property by the Aukeen district court, and that the rights requested by the City of Kent are surplus to the county's present and foreseeable needs;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The county executive is authorized to sign and deliver to the City of Kent a pedestrian and bicycle trail easement, substantially in the form of Exhibit "A" for the construction, operation and maintenance of a trail and related appurtenances over, upon, and across the following described property, situated in King County, Washington.

That portion of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 30, Township 22 North, Range 5 East, W. M., more fully described as follows:

That portion of Tract 24, except the South 50.00 feet lying East of the West 445.00 feet thereof, Horseshoe Acre Tracts to Kent, according to the Plat recorded in Volume 15 of Plats, Page 10, Records of King County, Washington, together with naturally accreted uplands, if any, attached thereof by operation of law, all of which lies between the line of mean high water of the Green River (White River) and the following described line:

Commencing at the intersection of South 262nd Street (Alder Lane) and 85th Avenue South (Maple Lane); thence South 89 · 42′ 58" East, along the Easterly extension of South 262nd Street, a distance of 133.40 feet; thence North 58 · 34′ 23" West, a distance of 65.76 feet; thence North 48 · 04′ 55" West, a distance of 53.14 feet; thence North 49 · 18′ 16" West, a distance of 55.60 feet; thence North 48 · 53′ 41" West, a distance of 49.47 feet; thence North 40 · 00′ 01" West, a distance of 67.34 feet; thence North 40 · 27′ 19" West, a distance of 50.52 feet; thence North 07 · 41′ 58" West, a distance of 57.39 feet to the True Point of Beginning; thence North 02 · 26′ 59" East, a distance of 51.11 feet; thence North 04 · 37′ 25" East, a distance of 51.89 feet; thence North 04 · 12′ 34" East, a distance of 57.47 feet; thence North 08 · 20′ 11" East a distance of 57.47 feet; thence North 08 · 20′ 11" East a distance of 50.95 feet; thence North 42 · 04′ 20" East, a distance of 55.36 feet; thence North 40 · 36′ 38" East, a distance of 55.36 feet; thence North 40 · 36′ 38" East, a distance of 50.81 feet to the terminus of said described line.
