A MOTION authorizing the county executive to make a grant application for funds in the approximate amount of \$1,125,000 to support a HIV/AIDS outreach and intervention program, Grant File No. 223.

WHEREAS, injecting drug users and their partners have been shown to underutilize and utilize inappropriately existing social support and service programs, and

WHEREAS, injection drug use is a significant factor in the transmission of the Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV) and the incidence of the Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome (AIDS), and

WHEREAS, a significant number of King County's estimated
12,000 injecting drug users who are engaged in high risk behavior
are located in Downtown Seattle, and

WHEREAS, the impact of community based outreach and intervention on injecting drug using population has not been documented in research, and

WHEREAS, collaborating efforts will expand outreach efforts to high risk substance users and their sexual partners in Seattle to reduce the spread of HIV/AIDS in the community, and

WHEREAS, by identifying injecting drug users and other high risk substance users and their partners, providing AIDS information and education, and encouraging participation in chemical dependency treatment, behaviors which provide the major routes of transmission of the virus can be modified or eliminated to check the advancement of this disease, and

WHEREAS, the Office of Treatment Improvement, through the State Division of Alcohol and Substance Abuse, is empowered to make grants in support of programs which could provide outreach and intervention services in reducing HIV risk behavior among injecting drug users and improve the effectiveness of drug abuse treatment services and help to reduce the spread of HIV/AIDS in the country;
