2 A MOTION authorizing the County Executive, or his
3 designee, to accept the designation as lead agency
4 for administration of Homeless Child Care funds
5 in King County and to contract with the Washington
6 Department of Social and Health Services for
7 providing and administering homeless child care
8 in the amount of \$303,884.

9 WHEREAS, the 1991 Washington State Legislature authorized
10 federal child care block grant funding to be used for a state
11 homeless child care program, and

12 WHEREAS, the Washington Department of Social and Health
13 Services initiated the State Homeless Child Care Program and
14 requested collaborative proposals from agencies in each county
15 with homeless children, and

16 WHEREAS, the community-based homeless child care planning
17 group which convened in King County has identified the King
18 County Child Care Program as the most appropriate lead agency to
19 administer this funding, and

20 WHEREAS, the City of Seattle Comprehensive Child Care Program
21 has committed an additional \$5,000 to the King County Child Care
22 Program to support the administration of this complex program, and

23 WHEREAS, County council Motion 7514 which set guidelines for
24 the King County Child Care Program directed the program to serve
25 children who are homeless, and

26 WHEREAS, the \$303,884 state allocation to King County for
27 homeless child care for the 1991-1993 biennium is nearing its
28 midpoint and must be spent by June 30, 1993;

29 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:


30 A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to enter
31 into a contract with the Washington Department of Social & Health
32 Services for the King County Homeless Child Care Program in the
33 amount of \$303,884 to coordinate and administer funding for
homeless child care services in King County, and

B. The King County executive is hereby authorized to enter
into a contract with the City of Seattle Comprehensive Child Care


1 Program for local matching funds to administer the King County
2 Homeless Child Care Program.
