A MOTION authorizing an additional \$144,401 in Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) dollars to be allocated to CDBG Project C92461 King County Housing Authority Housing Repair and Weatherization.

WHEREAS, rehabilitation and preservation of existing low-income housing is a pressing community need in King County, and

WHEREAS, the availability of rehabilitation loan funds is critical to low-income homeowners' ability to repair their homes, and

WHEREAS, the King County Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program matches the needs of low- and moderate-income homeowners in King County with the rehabilitation programs and resources available, and

WHEREAS, the King County Housing Authority's (KCHA) housing repair program needs additional funds in order to deliver needed low-income owner-occupied housing repair services beyond October 1992, and

WHEREAS, the King County council has appropriated a sum of \$147,401 to CDBG project C92608 Unallocated in budget ordinance 10182, and


WHEREAS, the exact amount of the 1992 CDBG entitlement grant is now known and the actual amount of available unallocated dollars is \$144,401;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The amount of \$144,401 in 1992 CDBG funds is authorized to be transferred from C92608 Unallocated to C92461 KCHA Housing Repair and Weatherization.
