MOTION NO. 8766

A MOTION related to county-wide planning policies; declaring King County's policy that appeals of the policies by cities to the growth management hearings board should be allowed at the conclusion of Phase II of county implementation of the Growth Management Act as set forth in Ordinance 10450.

WHEREAS, to meet the requirements of RCW 36.70A.210, King County, Seattle, and suburban cities established a process through an interlocal agreement creating the Growth Management Planning Council (GMPC) to recommend county-wide planning policies to the King County Council, and

WHEREAS, on July 6, 1992 by Ordinance 10450 the King County Council adopted the county-wide planning policies as Phase I of the county's implementation of the major planning requirements of the Growth Management Act (GMA), and

WHEREAS, in Phase II, commencing no later than December 19921, the GMPC shall evaluate information and recommendations on nominations of urban and manufacturing/industrial centers by affected jurisdictions and other issues and recommend potential amendments to the policies to the county, and

WHEREAS, such amendments to the county-wide planning policy, if adopted by the county and ratified by cities, could result in significant changes to the county-wide planning policies, and

WHEREAS, the GMA allows appeals of adopted county-wide planning policies by cities and the governor to the growth planning hearings board within sixty days of the adoption of the county-wide planning policy, and

WHEREAS, cities should not be required to appeal the recently adopted Phase I policies simply to preserve the right to appeal any amended county-wide planning policies adopted as a result of Phase II;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: 1 A. It is the policy of King County that appeals by cities 2 to the growth management hearings board of any amended county-3 wide planning policies adopted in Phase II of the comprehensive 4 5 planning process described in Ordinance 10450 should be allowed notwithstanding a city's decision not to appeal the policies 6 adopted in Phase I. 7 PASSED this Both day of Deptember 8 KING COUNTY COUNCIL q KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON 10 11 12 ATTEST: 13 15
