2 A MOTION appointing committees to write
3 voters pamphlet statements for the
4 November 3, 1992 general election.

5 WHEREAS, King County Code authorizes county participation
6 in voters pamphlets for all issues on the November 3, 1992
7 general elections, and

8 WHEREAS, Ordinance 10531 provides for submission to the
9 voters on November 3, 1992 a charter amendment merging the
10 Municipality on Metropolitan Seattle and King County, and

11 WHEREAS, Ordinance 10530 provides for submission to the
12 voters amendments to Articles 2 and 6 of the King County
13 Charter concerning the legislative branch and elections;
14 providing for thirteen county council members and for regional
15 committees to recommend and review ordinances adopting county -
16 wide policies; establishing special ordinances affecting only
17 unincorporated areas of the county; granting cities the power
18 to initiate ordinances; and submitting the same to the voters
19 of the county and establishing a date for election, and

20 WHEREAS, Ordinance 10534 provides for the submission to
21 the voters on November 3, 1992 a proposition authorizing an
22 increase in the regular property tax levy in excess of the 106
23 percent levy limitation for five consecutive years beginning in
24 1992, with collection rate of not more than \$.302 per \$1,000 of
25 assessed valuation, pursuant to RCW 84.55.050, as amended, for
26 the purpose of paying for planning, site acquisition, design,
27 construction, equipping and furnishing of the Phase I Regional
28 Justice Center; remodelling of the King County Correctional
29 Facility; preliminary planning and site acquisition for the
30 Phase II Regional Justice Center; and operation of the
31 Intensive Drug Treatment Program;
