A MOTION encouraging all citizens to
exercise their right to register and vote.

WHEREAS, King County encourages all citizens to register
to vote and participate in our primary and general elections,
and

WHEREAS, the National Association of Counties and the
League of Women Voters of the United States have joined
together to promote the 1992 National Voter Registration Drive,
September 12 - 19, 1992 and

WHEREAS, the registration campaign emphasizes the values of
voting to preserve the benefits of a representative democracy,
and

WHEREAS, While other countries in the world are
encouraging the creation of democratic systems which establish
the right of popular voting, participation in the electoral
process has declined in the United States and in our area, and

WHEREAS, the National Association of Counties and the
League of Women Voters are to be commended for this program,
calling our attention to the importance of registering and
informed voting, and providing citizens across the country with
the opportunity to obtain voter information and to vote, and

WHEREAS, anyone can register anytime, but prospective
voters must be registered 30 days before the election to
qualify to vote, and

WHEREAS, October 3, 1992 is the last day to register or
transfer registration to qualify to vote in the November 3,
1992 general election, and

WHEREAS, the League of Women Voters and the Division of
King County Records and Elections should be recognized for
coordinating voter information, campaign forums and
registration activities in local businesses, fire stations,

1 public libraries, community service centers, colleges, high
2 schools and other locations;


3 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:
