3 Recycle Week in King County and recognizing
4 outstanding efforts in the area of waste
5 reduction, recycling, and buying recycling
6 products in King County during the past
7 year.

8 WHEREAS, King County has established waste reduction and
9 recycling goals of 35 percent in 1992, 50 percent in 1995, and
10 65 percent in 2000, and is known as a national leader in
11 recycling, and

12 WHEREAS, the King County Solid Waste Division is holding
13 its fourth annual Recycle Week from October 3 through October
14 11, 1992, to increase public awareness of and participation in
15 waste reduction, recycling, and the use of recycled products,
16 and

17 WHEREAS, part of the Recycle Week celebration is an awards
18 program to recognize outstanding efforts of individuals,
19 businesses, schools, community groups, and public agencies that
20 have helped make possible the achievement of King County's
21 first waste reduction and recycling goal this year;

22 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

23 The week of October 3 - 11, 1992 is proclaimed Recycle Week
24 in King County.

26 The council recognizes the efforts of those groups,
27 businesses and individuals who will be awarded King County
28 Recycle Week '92 outstanding achievement awards on October 9,
29 1992.
