2 A MOTION authorizing the executive to  
3 make a grant application for funds in  
4 the amount of \$92,253 to support the  
5 evaluation of emergency medical services  
6 system components associated with long  
7 term survival and quality of life.

9 WHEREAS, the University of Washington School of Medicine is  
10 empowered to make grants and support programs that provide for  
11 the evaluation of emergency medicine services, and

12  
13 WHEREAS, the King County emergency medical services  
14 division coordinates and directs the provision of emergency  
15 medical services and maintains information on the incidence of  
16 out-of-hospital sudden cardiac death, and

17  
18 WHEREAS, the Council of King County finds that the  
19 evaluation of emergency medical services is in the public  
20 interest;

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22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

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24 A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to make  
25 application for funds in the amount of \$93,253 to the Elisha  
26 Fund of the University of Washington School of Medicine to  
27 support the evaluation of emergency medical services system  
28 components associated with long term survival and quality of  
29 life on behalf of King County.

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31 B. The King County executive is hereby authorized to file  
32 and execute such application and enter into and execute such  
33 contracts as are required by the grantor.

1 C. The King County executive is also authorized to enter  
2 into such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation  
3 of the project.

4 D. The University of Washington is hereby assured full  
5 compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act
