A MOTION authorizing the executive to make a grant application for funds in the amount of \$92,253 to support the evaluation of emergency medical services system components associated with long term survival and quality of life.

WHEREAS, the University of Washington School of Medicine is empowered to make grants and support programs that provide for the evaluation of emergency medicine services, and

WHEREAS, the King County emergency medical services division coordinates and directs the provision of emergency medical services and maintains information on the incidence of out-of-hospital sudden cardiac death, and

WHEREAS, the Council of King County finds that the evaluation of emergency medical services is in the public interest;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the amount of \$93,253 to the Elisha Fund of the University of Washington School of Medicine to support the evaluation of emergency medical services system components associated with long term survival and quality of life on behalf of King County.
- B. The King County executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such application and enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the grantor.
