2 A MOTION authorizing an interlocal agreement between
3 King County and the City of Bellevue to implement
4 a child care voucher program for eligible residents
5 of the City of Bellevue.

6 WHEREAS, King County's child care program operates a child
7 care voucher program for eligible residents in King County outside
8 of the City of Seattle, as established pursuant to motion
9 7514, and

10 WHEREAS, it is the intent of the council to encourage
11 suburban cities to participate in the King County Child Care
12 Program, and

13 WHEREAS, the City of Bellevue has adopted child care policies
14 which authorize the City to work with other public agencies to
15 increase the availability of quality child care for low-income
16 families, and

17 WHEREAS, the City of Bellevue wishes to implement its child
18 care policy objectives by establishing a child care voucher
19 program to be administered by the King County Child Care Program,
20 and,

21 WHEREAS, the City of Bellevue has appropriated \$63,000 to
22 support a child care voucher program in 1992 and is planning to
23 continue the appropriation for 1993, and

24 WHEREAS, the intent of Bellevue's establishment of a child
25 care voucher program is to expand the supply of quality child care
26 available to low income residents of the City of Bellevue, and

27 WHEREAS, the King County Child Care Program anticipates no
28 additional costs for administering the Bellevue child care voucher
29 program in 1992 and 1993;

30 NOW THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

31 The King County executive is authorized to enter into an
32 interlocal agreement with the City of Bellevue extending through
33 the end of 1993 to provide a child care voucher program for
eligible residents of the City of Bellevue which shall contain

1 a provision that the Bellevue Child Care voucher funds will not be
2 used to supplant existing subsidies provided to residents of
3 Bellevue through the King County child care program.
