A MOTION relating to a King County/Metro Consolidation Transition Committee and a Consolidation Advisory Committee.

WHEREAS, on November 3 voters approved King County Proposition 1 and King County Charter Amendment 1 consolidating King County government and the Municipality of Metropolitan Seattle (Metro), and

WHEREAS, through consolidation our region has an opportunity to create a government that incorporates the best attributes of King County and Metro, and

WHEREAS, a spirit of collaboration, cooperation and partnership will be needed to plan and implement a transition of King County and Metro to regional government, and

WHEREAS, King County, Metro, the City of Seattle, suburban cities, and the citizens of our region share a common interest in realizing a successful transition.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County executive is requested to join with the county council to convene a Consolidation Transition Committee to include the executive, four county councilmembers, two elected representatives of the City of Seattle, and two elected representatives of the suburban cities. During 1993 the Committee shall be responsible for providing policy guidance on issues relating to the transition;


BE IT FURTHER MOVED,

The King County executive and county council shall jointly appoint a Consolidation Advisory Committee with membership from business and civic organizations including persons who have specific knowledge of King County and Metro governmental


