A MOTION authorizing the King County Executive to enter into an interlocal cooperation agreement with the City of Kent and the Housing Authority of the County of King in order to implement a low-income housing project funded with King County Housing Opportunity Funds.

WHEREAS, the 1992 King County Comprehensive Housing Affordability
Strategy, adopted by the King County council and approved by the United States
Department of Housing and Urban Development, outlines strategies and housing
production goals to address the needs of low-income households in King County,
and

WHEREAS, the King County Housing Opportunity Fund was established in 1990 to assist with the development of affordable housing for the county's homeless, displaced, and special needs groups, and

WHEREAS, a proposal by the City of Kent has been selected for funding with Housing Opportunity Funds in accordance with council-approved guidelines, and

WHEREAS, the City of Kent will use Housing Opportunity Funds to assist with the acquisition of improved property in which to house and serve frail elderly citizens of unincorporated King County, and

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority of the County of King has been selected by the City of Kent to own and manage this property, and

WHEREAS, this interlocal cooperation agreement will regulate the use of property acquired with funds from the Housing Opportunity Fund for the useful life of such property, and

WHEREAS, King County, the City of Kent, and the Housing Authority of the County of King are authorized to enter into such interlocal cooperation agreements pursuant to RCW 39.34;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County executive is hereby authorized to enter into an interlocal cooperation agreement substantially in the form of Attachment A with the City of Kent and the Housing Authority of the County of King for funding of \$250,000 for a Housing Opportunity Fund project selected in 1990 in accordance with the policies and procedures specified in Ordinance 9369, as amended, for acquisition of housing for the frail elderly.
