MOTION NO. 8855

A MOTION referring pending road vacation requests and denial appeals to the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner's Office.

WHEREAS, the King County council has decided to have the zoning and subdivision examiner's office receive and study recommendations for approval of road vacation requests from the department of public works; and

WHEREAS, the zoning and subdivision examiner's office has also been empowered to hear appeals of denials of road vacation requests; and

WHEREAS, the zoning and subdivision examiner shall receive from the department of public works the information necessary to formulate a recommendation to the King County council; and

WHEREAS, the zoning and subdivision examiner shall hold public hearings, and insure that the public shall have a voice; and

WHEREAS, the King County council shall retain its authority to approve or reject road vacation requests recommended by the zoning and subdivision examiner's office; and

WHEREAS, the delegation of responsibility for making recommendations to the King County council on the matter of road vacation requests and appeals of denials is allowable under state law;


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. Any, and all, road vacation ordinances and appeals of denials of road vacation requests, either introduced or un-introduced, before the King County council as of the effective date of this motion are referred to the zoning and subdivision examiner's office for consideration and action.

2 prepare and forward to the King County council for
3 consideration and action any and all proposed road vacation
4 ordinances and appeals of denials, if granted, referred to it
5 by this motion.
