A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to apply to the Department of Ecology for grant funds to enable the Commission for Marketing Recyclable Materials to implement a Retail Outreach Project.

WHEREAS, WAC 173-312 provides for the award of Coordinated Prevention Grants (CPG) by the Department of Ecology pursuant to RCW 70.105D.070(3) (the Model Toxics Control Act) to assist local governments with hazardous and solid waste management planning and program implementation, and

WHEREAS, the Commission for Marketing Recyclable Materials (the Marketing Commission) is charged under the Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Plan with developing markets for recyclable commodities collected in King County, and

WHEREAS, the Marketing Commission proposes to implement a Retail Outreach Project that would: (1) encourage King County retailers to market recycled products and (2) educate consumers about the importance of buying recycled products, and

WHEREAS, the Marketing Commission is eligible to apply for and use CPG funds for these activities, and

WHEREAS, the cost of the project is \$81,540, of which \$48,924 is proposed to be funded by CPG and \$32,616 through the Marketing Commission's budget, and

WHEREAS, this match shall be met through 1993 appropriated expenditure authority;

1.	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:
2	A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to apply to the
3	Department of Ecology for \$48,924 in CPG funds for a Retail Outreach
4	Project.
5	B. The King County executive is hereby authorized to file and
6	execute such application and to enter into and execute such contracts as
7	are required by the grantor.
8	C. The King County executive is also authorized to enter into and
9	execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the
10	project.
