WHEREAS, "Sharing the Dream - Today and Tomorrow," is the theme for the Sixth Annual Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Celebration, focusing on the equality of employees and departments of King County, and

WHEREAS, this year's celebration highlights special county programs and projects that reach beyond the normal responsibility of local government to promote equality, cultural diversity and unity, and

WHEREAS, Dr. King, born on January 15, 1929, worked to unite and protect the rights of all individuals, prompting the passage of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the Voting Rights Act of 1965, and

WHEREAS, on February 24, 1986, the King County Council set forth the historical basis for redesignating King County in honor of Dr. King;
