A MOTION authorizing the Executive to enter into an agreement with Northwest Pipeline Corporation for a franchise to reconstruct, operate and maintain a gas transmission system in Council District 9.

WHEREAS, Northwest Pipeline Corporation has filed an application for a franchise in Council District 9 to reconstruct, operate and maintain a gas transmission system in accordance with R.C.W. 36.55.010, and

WHEREAS, Northwest Pipeline Corporation obtained an approved franchise from King County for its present gas transmission line route in 1986 under Motion 6485, and

WHEREAS, during the heavy rains and flooding in November, 1990 and January, 1991 the two 10-inch gas transmission lines were exposed in the Madsen Creek channel leaving them suspended about five feet above the creek, and

WHEREAS, Northwest Pipeline Corporation addressed the gas transmission lines damage by replacing the damaged section and constructing a suspension bridge to support the span, and

WHEREAS, in order to address the long term stability of the transmission lines, potential public safety risks and to avoid recurring washouts Northwest Pipeline Corporation wishes to relocate the lines outside of the creek bed, and

WHEREAS, Northwest Pipeline Corporation is currently in the process of obtaining the required construction permits from the King County building and land development/environmental division for the relocation, and

WHEREAS, the application has been referred to the county departments for review, and

WHEREAS, the county executive has recommended approval of the franchise;
