MOTION NO. **8932**

A MOTION supporting Northwest Racing Associates' proposal to build a thoroughbred horse park in the City of Auburn.

WHEREAS, the closing of Longacres Park in Renton has left western Washington without a race track and facilities sufficient to accommodate significant thoroughbred racing activities, and

WHEREAS, Northwest Racing Associates, a Washington limited partnership, proposes to obtain land use approvals and construction approvals for a thoroughbred horse racing park on approximately 190 acres in Auburn, and

WHEREAS, the facility known as the Auburn Thoroughbred Racetrack would include a one-mile oval racetrack, horse stalls, grandstands, restaurants, parimutuel windows, and appropriate parking and accessories, and

WHEREAS, construction of a new racing facility is estimated to provide approximately 900 full-time and part-time jobs and when completed the facility would employ 550 people, and

WHEREAS, many thousands of King County residents, attend and support thoroughbred racing events, and the location of a new state-licensed (class B) track in King County will maintain and enhance the economy and recreational opportunities of the county and the state, and

WHEREAS, King County contains breeding farms and training farms for thoroughbred race horses which employ many people and contribute to the viability of agriculture in the county, and

WHEREAS, the proposal for Auburn Thoroughbred Racetrack 1 is consistent with King County Comprehensive Plan policies 2 particularly E-213 which calls for racetracks to be located 3 within urban areas where facilities are available to serve the 4 site, and 5 WHEREAS, the proposed Auburn Thoroughbred Racetrack would 6 7 be consistent with county policies to protect farmland particularly on the Enumclaw Plateau and Snoqualmie Valley 8 where a voter-approved bond issue has been used to purchase the 9 development rights of prime agricultural land, and 10 WHEREAS, Northwest Racing Associates has entered into a 11 lease for the proposed Auburn site, raised \$20,000,000 in 12 equity financing, obtained \$16,000,000 in bank financing, and 13 14 filed an application with the Washington Horse Racing Commission for a license, and 15 WHEREAS, Northwest Racing Associates has requested no 16 public funds in order to implement its proposal, and 17 18 WHEREAS, King County will realize both property tax and sales tax revenue from Auburn Thoroughbred Racetrack, 19 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: 20 The council supports Northwest Racing Associates' 21 proposal to site a racetrack in Auburn. 22 The council clerk shall forward copies of this motion 23 to the appropriate officials of the City of Auburn and the 24 Washington State Horse Racing Commission. 25 8 th day of March PASSED this 26 KING COUNTY COUNCIL 27 KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON 28 This / ////leva 29 30 ATTEST: 31 32 33
