A MOTION affirming a commitment to sponsor the SS VIRGINIA V Foundation's request for federal transportation enhancement funding and requesting the executive to prepare legislation to appropriate the necessary matching funds.

WHEREAS, the SS VIRGINIA V is the only remaining ship from the historic "Mosquito Fleet" that constituted the Puget Sound region's first major public transportation system, and

WHEREAS, the SS VIRGINIA V Foundation has projected the need for about \$1,200,000 to fully restore the ship over a number of years and is proceeding with the work in annual phases of \$100,000 to \$150,000, and

WHEREAS, the SS VIRGINIA V Foundation has privately raised about \$35,000 towards the next phase of restoration, and

WHEREAS, the King County Landmarks and Heritage Commission supports the Foundation's efforts and has awarded county funding in past phases, and

WHEREAS, the Intermodal Surface Transportation Efficiency Act of 1991 (ISTEA) is a federal law that provides funding for transportation enhancements, and

WHEREAS, the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) has requested applications for the use of ISTEA funds for transportation enhancement projects including a category for historic preservation projects, and

each applicant for such transportation WHEREAS, enhancement project funding must be sponsored by a public agency and must have matching funds from other public sources of at least 13.5%, and

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
