A MOTION authorizing applications for funding assistance for projects from the Metro Regional Shoreline Improvement Fund.

WHEREAS, King County has approved an "Open Space Plan" identifying trails, natural areas and greenbelts which are needed to develop a quality park and open space system, and

WHEREAS, the county is in the process of completing a comprehensive park and recreation plan, and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of an agreement between Metro and the City of Seattle, funding assistance has been authorized and made available to aid in financing the cost of land and the construction of facilities for public access to, and enhancement of, regionally significant shorelines, and

WHEREAS. King County considers it in the best public interest to acquire those shoreline properties identified in paragraph B below;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- A. The King County Executive is authorized to make formal application to the Metro Regional Shoreline Improvement Fund.
- B. That any fund assistance so received be used in the acquisition and development of the following projects:

Project	Type	Location
Mueller Property	Acquire approximately 100 feet shoreline on Lake Washington	Northshore community
Reserve "M" Tract/ Innis Arden	Acquire 23 acre site on Puget Sound	Shoreline community
Cold Creek/ Redondo Beach	Acquisition of property on tributary to Puget Sound	Redondo Beach
Boeing Creek	Acquisition of property on tributary into Puget Sound	Shoreline
Mother of the River/ North Wind Weir	Acquisition of property on the Duwamish Waterway	Highline
Maury Island Gravel Pit	Aquisition of saltwater shoreline contiguous to exiting public property	Vashon Island

- C. King County does hereby certify that, if a specific project grant is accepted, the county will fully support its grant match commitments.
- D. Any property acquired with financial aid through the Metro Regional Shoreline Improvement Fund shall be used in accordance with the terms of financial aid by Metro.
- E. This motion shall be part of the formal application to the Metro Regional Shoreline Improvement Fund.
