2 A MOTION accepting the Redondo Seawall
3 Reconstruction Final Environmental Impact
4 Statement and requesting revisions in the
5 Executive's recommendations which address
6 the regional transportation and park
7 needs.

8 WHEREAS, the county has desired to make necessary
9 improvements to the Redondo Beach Road Seawall to protect
10 private property, utilities, and the public right-of-way, and

11 WHEREAS, a severe storm in December of 1990 damaged
12 Redondo Beach Road South extensively and forced the temporary
13 closure to traffic, and

14 WHEREAS, council by Motion 8598 in April of 1992,
15 supported an interim opening of Redondo Beach Road South to
16 one-way traffic northbound with certain time restrictions until
17 council approval of the final environmental impact statement
18 (FEIS), or until March 31, 1993 whichever occurred first, and

19 WHEREAS, strong community demand exists for addressing
20 both the mobility needs of the Redondo area and for preserving
21 the precious natural resource of Redondo Beach as a public
22 park, and

23 WHEREAS, the executive has completed and issued the FEIS
24 for the Redondo Seawall Reconstruction, and

25 WHEREAS, the executive in transmitting the FEIS has
26 recommended calling for the establishment of a regional park at
27 Redondo Beach, and the ultimate closure of Redondo Beach Road
28 South as the areas road network is improved to accommodate the
29 long-term traffic impacts;

30 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

31 A. The King county council has considered the Redondo
32 Beach Seawall Reconstruction Final Environmental Impact
33 Statement and the executive's recommendations and supports the
34 concept of establishing a regional park at Redondo Beach and
35 the ultimate closure of Redondo Beach Road South.

1 B. The council requests the executive to prepare an
 2 appropriation ordinance to fund a park master plan and
 3 environmental assessment to identify the parking,
 4 transportation access, park facilities design, and resource
 5 issues associated with establishing a Redondo Regional Park.


6 C. The council requests the executive to develop any
 7 required appropriation ordinances and to request authorization
 8 to enter into cost sharing agreements with the Washington
 9 Department of Transportation and other agencies to study and
 10 design improvements on State Routes 509 and 99 and other area
 11 roads needed to accommodate the impacts of a closure of Redondo
 12 Beach Road South as a part of creating the Redondo Beach
 13 Regional Park.

14 D. The council requests the executive to proceed with
 15 making interim improvements to Redondo Beach Seawall.


16 E. The council supports the continued operation of Redondo
 17 Beach Road South 6:00 a.m. until noon, Monday through Friday,
 18 one-way northbound until June 1, 1993 or the execution of
 19 conservation easements, whichever is earlier,
