WHEREAS, a severe storm in December of 1990 damaged Redondo Beach Road South extensively and forced the temporary closure to traffic, and

WHEREAS, council by Motion 8598 in April of 1992, supported an interim opening of Redondo Beach Road South to one-way traffic northbound with certain time restrictions until council approval of the final environmental impact statement (FEIS), or until March 31, 1993 whichever occurred first, and

WHEREAS, strong community demand exists for addressing both the mobility needs of the Redondo area and for preserving the precious natural resource of Redondo Beach as a public park, and

WHEREAS, the executive has completed and issued the FEIS for the Redondo Seawall Reconstruction, and

WHEREAS, the executive in transmitting the FEIS has recommended calling for the establishment of a regional park at Redondo Beach, and the ultimate closure of Redondo Beach Road South as the areas road network is improved to accommodate the long-term traffic impacts;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King county council has considered the Redondo Beach Seawall Reconstruction Final Environmental Impact Statement and the executive's recommendations and supports the concept of establishing a regional park at Redondo Beach and the ultimate closure of Redondo Beach Road South.
