A MOTION authorizing the county executive to sign the attached conservation easements in substantially the form herein and to develop a linear passive public park at Redondo Beach to maximize this exceptional opportunity to provide access to our Puget Sound shoreline.

WHEREAS, Redondo Beach Drive S.W. received significant 9 10 damage and was closed as a result of storm damage in December 11 of 1990, and

WHEREAS, repair of the road is estimated to cost more than \$8 million, and significantly impact the shoreline, and

WHEREAS, traffic that used the road prior to its closure is more efficiently accommodated by improving other components 16 of the State and local road system, and

WHEREAS, opportunities for public access and enjoyment of 17 18 Puget Sound are exceedingly scarce, and

WHEREAS the citizens of Redondo Beach have submitted to 19 the County a public spirited, generous offer of donated 20 Conservation Easements to this remarkable shoreline which would 21 secure for the people of King County permanent access to Puget 22 23 Sound for recreation and enjoyment, and

WHEREAS the Redondo Beach citizens have agreed to execute 24 any mutually agreeable modifications to the Deed and agreement 25 26 as may be necessary based on further review, and

WHEREAS the property right offered by the Redondo Citizens 27 would cost the taxpayers of the County more than \$1 million if 28 29 it were purchased rather than donated, and

WHEREAS, the offer of donated Conservation Easements 30 expires on March 31, 1993; 31

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: 32 The Executive is authorized to accept and execute the 33 conservation deeds and agreements provided however that there 34 must be the execution of mutually acceptable modifications to 35

the deed and agreement as may be necessary based on further review by legal counsel, the office of the prosecuting attorney, council and executive staff and council approval of such modifications by June 1, 1993.
