

MOTION NO. 8952

A MOTION authorizing the county executive to enter into an agreement with the Municipality of Metropolitan Seattle (Metro) for commute trip reduction implementation services.

WHEREAS, the state legislature has passed the Commute Trip Reduction (CTR) law as part of the Clean Air Washington Act (RCW 70.94.521 through 70.94.551), a law requiring local governments to adopt commute trip reduction plans and ordinances to regulate major employers, and

WHEREAS, the CTR law requires jurisdictions to identify and review employer programs on an annual basis, and

WHEREAS, the City of Seattle and other local jurisdictions are likely to contract with the Municipality of Metropolitan Seattle (Metro) for implementation services, and

WHEREAS, Metro has the staff available to discharge these duties, and


WHEREAS, the county would have to hire staff to carry out these same duties already available through Metro staff;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The county executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with Metro for CTR implementation services.
