A MOTION creating Unincorporated Area Governance Strategies Committees in Covington and Kenmore and establishing timelines for completion of the work of these committees

7 WHEREAS, the citizens of King County have approved by 8 ballot an expanded King County council, merger of King County 9 and the Municipality of Metropolitan Seattle (METRO), and 10 significantly changed the relationship between the county and 11 cities by establishing regional transit, water quality, and 12 affairs committees, and

WHEREAS, the King County council believes that any change in local government must respect the right of unincorporated areas to self-determination, and

WHEREAS, the King County council recognizes that new options may be developed to improve local government in addition to incorporation or annexation to existing cities, and

WHEREAS, the King County council acknowledges that
citizens may identify measures to make the existing form of
unincorporated area government more accessible and responsive
to unincorporated King County citizens, and

WHEREAS, the unincorporated communities of Shoreline,
Vashon Island, and White Center/Boulevard Park have
successfully participated in Unincorporated Area Governance
Strategies Committees since early 1992;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. the Unincorporated Area Governance Strategies Committees are hereby established in the unincorporated communities of Kenmore and Covington

B. The members of the Unincorporated Areas Governance
Strategies Committees for Covington and Kenmore shall be

appointed by the King County councilmember who represents each community.

C. The boundaries for the area to be included in the work of the committee shall be determined by the King County councilmember who represents the community.

D. The Unincorporated Area Governance Strategies Committees for Covington and Kenmore shall commence their work not more than 30 days after the members are notified of their appointment; shall submit a preliminary report of their work during January of 1994; and shall submit a final report of their work to the King County council by July 1, 1994.

E. The preliminary and final reports of the Kenmore and Covington Unincorporated Governance Strategies Committees shall be presented at public meetings prior to transmission to the King County council.

F. The King County council shall respond to each of the final reports by October 1, 1994.
