2 A MOTION creating Unincorporated Area
3 Governance Strategies Committees in
4 Covington and Kenmore and establishing
5 timelines for completion of the work of
6 these committees

7 WHEREAS, the citizens of King County have approved by
8 ballot an expanded King County council, merger of King County
9 and the Municipality of Metropolitan Seattle (METRO), and
10 significantly changed the relationship between the county and
11 cities by establishing regional transit, water quality, and
12 affairs committees, and

13 WHEREAS, the King County council believes that any change
14 in local government must respect the right of unincorporated
15 areas to self-determination, and

16 WHEREAS, the King County council recognizes that new
17 options may be developed to improve local government in
18 addition to incorporation or annexation to existing cities, and

19 WHEREAS, the King County council acknowledges that
20 citizens may identify measures to make the existing form of
21 unincorporated area government more accessible and responsive
22 to unincorporated King County citizens, and

23 WHEREAS, the unincorporated communities of Shoreline,
24 Vashon Island, and White Center/Boulevard Park have
25 successfully participated in Unincorporated Area Governance
26 Strategies Committees since early 1992;

27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King
28 County:

29 A. the Unincorporated Area Governance Strategies
30 Committees are hereby established in the unincorporated
31 communities of Kenmore and Covington

32 B. The members of the Unincorporated Areas Governance
33 Strategies Committees for Covington and Kenmore shall be

1 appointed by the King County councilmember who represents each
2 community.

3 C. The boundaries for the area to be included in the work
4 of the committee shall be determined by the King County
5 councilmember who represents the community.


6 D. The Unincorporated Area Governance Strategies
7 Committees for Covington and Kenmore shall commence their work
8 not more than 30 days after the members are notified of their
9 appointment; shall submit a preliminary report of their work
10 during January of 1994; and shall submit a final report of
11 their work to the King County council by July 1, 1994.

12 E. The preliminary and final reports of the Kenmore and
13 Covington Unincorporated Governance Strategies Committees shall
14 be presented at public meetings prior to transmission to the
15 King County council.


16 F. The King County council shall respond to each of the
17 final reports by October 1, 1994.
